Author and screenwriter **Mariolina Venezia** (Matera 1961), after publishing three books of poetry in France, won the Campiello Award in 2007 for her novel *Mille anni che sto qui (Been Here a Thousand Years, 2010)*, the generational saga of a family in Basilicata over 150 years, from the Unification of Italy to the fall of the Berlin Wall. Venezia writes scripts for film (*Dove non ho mai abitato* by Paolo Franchi) and television (*La Squadra, 48 ore*), and contributes to a number of literary magazines.
