Johnnie To has directed over 40 films and produced as many. He began his career in the 1970s working for the TVB network as a director, screenwriter and producer. In 1980 he made his feature debut, *The Enigmatic Case*. Commercial success came in 1989 with *All About Ah-Long*. Three years later he made the equally successful *The Heroic Trio*. In 1996 he and Wai Ka Fai founded the production company Milkyway Image and he began making more personal, original and visionary films across a wide range of genres. *Running out of Time* (1999), *The Mission* (1999), *Fulltime Killer*, (2001), *PTU* (2003) and *Breaking News* (2004) are just a few of his biggest hits. In 2005, *Election* was presented in Competition at the Cannes Film Festival. The following year, *Exiled* played in competition at the Venice Film Festival, at which he served on the International Jury in 2008. In 2009 he won the Black Lion Award in Courmayeur for *Vengeance*.
